# **Course Description**

- Loop course All distances made up from the 2K loop and 3K loop
- Entire course irrigated and graded for drainage
- Minimum course width is 10 meters throughout
- Starting line accommodates up to 40 teams and 550 meters to first sweeping turn
- 2K loop includes lightly rolling hills; sweeping, graded turns
- 3K loop has common first 1200m with 2K loop
- Last 1800m of 3K loop with sweeping, graded turns with slight uphill 300m finish
- Finish straight away of 300m is slightly uphill with elevated viewing berm

#### **Course Features**

- Permanent start/finish line adjacent to medical support and athlete recovery tent
- Fully graded and irrigated
- Viewing berms
- Course fencing
- Electronic K markers
- Dedicated tent city with easy access to start/finish

# **Course Inspection**

Course will be available Friday after 3pm (weather dependent). The course will be dedicated at 4pm with two collegiate races starting at 5pm. Race packets and meet merchandise will be available as well on Friday evening and Saturday morning. Please allow additional 15 minutes in your planning for vehicle drop-off and parking.

#### **Entry Information**

## **Inclement Weather Policy**

Meet organizers reserve the right to alter or cancel the meet due to inclement weather in the case that we deem conditions to be unsafe to compete or complete a given event. In general, we will follow the MSHSAA weather policy. In the case of lightning, we will delay the start of any event until 30 minutes after the last sighting of lightning. In the case of extreme heat, the event and the remaining races will be canceled if the heat index reaches 105 degrees. Race committee will begin to alter race distances if the heat index reaches 95 degrees or we deem conditions to be unsafe to complete the advertised distance.
